Mood Indigo: Children's Art Inspired by Duke Ellington Exhibition
February 28- April 12

Duke Ellington brought a level of style and sophistication unique even to the Jazz movement. Although he was a gifted piano player, his orchestra was his principal instrument. Ellington considered himself to be a composer of music and an arranger, rather than just a musician or performer.

The Totally Tubular after school program at Cedarhurst's Shrode Art Center designed a few of the sessions to incorporate Jazz music as an influence in their projects. The students each created a mixed media work of art while listening to Duke Ellington's jazz hit Mood Indigo.
