**Clara Brian: Home Bureau Photographs**

New Perspectives of Kuenz Sculpture Park by Dan Overturf opened on October 30 in the Beal Grand Corridor Gallery at Cedarhurst. The exhibit, features the work of Southern Illinois University-Carbondale professor of photography Dan Overturf. The exhibition photographs are artistic interpretations, or new perspectives, of the sculptures as well as the park.

The Beck Family Center Gallery is hosting the photographic exhibition Clara Brian: Home Bureau Photographs (1981-1926), October 30 through December 30, 2010. Clara Brian was the first Home Bureau advisor in Illinois.

As she traveled to remote parts of McLean County during 1918- 1926, carrying with her a folding 3 x 4 camera, she documented the women she served, their families, homes, schools, and other aspects of their lives. The prints in this exhibition were made by Rhondal McKinney in 1991 from Clara Brian's negatives.

A record number of entries were received for the annual Shrode Photography Competition Exhibit. Through a jurying process, approximately 40 entries were selected for the exhibition that opened October 30. The exhibit, cosponsored by Comfort Suites, will be in the Regenhardt Gallery at Shrode Art Center. The competition award recipients were announced at the opening reception on October 30th.
