Shrode Photography Competition Exhibition opens at Cedarhurst

An enthusiastic response to the annual photography competition at Cedarhurst Center for the Arts in Mt. Vernon garnered over 140 entries from approximately 45 artists in the southern Illinois area. The Shrode Photography Competition Exhibit was open to the public on Saturday, October 31 in the Regenhardt Gallery of the Shrode Art Center at Cedarhurst. The juried competition was open to all artists 18 years of age and older living in southern Illinois, south of Interstate 70.

Photographic film, digital photographs and digitally altered photography were the accepted media for this competition which was juried by St. Louis (MO) professional photographer Ray Marklin. Marklin's work is featured in the exhibition Rajasthan: Ancient Traditions, Modern Colors, which also opened October 31 at Cedarhurst.

An opening reception for 4 new exhibitions including the Shrode Photography Competition Exhibition was held on Saturday, November 7.

Awards for the Photography Competition will be presented to Best of Show as well as 1st, 2nd and 3rd place entries.
