Midwest artists featured in new exhibitions at Cedarhurst

Italian Suite: Works by Carol Carter, opened Friday, February 25 in the Main Gallery at Cedarhurst Center for the Arts. St. Louis artist Carol Carter's paintings of Italian cities and countrysides capture the imagination with her stunning use of color and texture. The exhibit, cosponsored by Fifth Third Bank, is Carter's most recent work, created during a month-long retreat to Italy.

An exhibition showcasing works from the Department of Cinema and Photography at SIU-C opened February 25 in the Beal Grand Corridor Gallery at Cedarhurst. The photography exhibition, an annual affair since the early 1990s, is one of many cooperative endeavors between Cedarhurst and Southern Illinois University. New Work by the Faculty, Students and Staff of the Department of Cinema and Photography at Southern Illinois University-Carbondale will feature both the works of talented students as well as art from the department's faculty and staff.

An enthusiastic response to the annual Shrode Art & Craft Competition at Cedarhurst Center for the Arts in Mt. Vernon garnered entries from many talented artists in the southern Illinois region. The exhibit, sponsored by St. Mary's Good Samaritan, Inc. and The Southern Illinoisan opened to the public on Friday, February 25 in the Regenhardt Gallery of the Shrode Art Center at Cedarhurst. The juried competition was open to all artists 18 years of age and older living in southern Illinois, south of Interstate 70.

Painting, drawing, printmaking, clay, fiber, mixed media, wood, fine jewelry, and metal were the accepted media for this competition which was juried by Jo Nast, an art history professor at Southern Illinois University - Carbondale.
