**Fiber, Ceramic, Abstract and Kids' Art featured in new exhibitions at Cedarhurst**

Structure and Harmony: Abstract Works from the Permanent Collection, opened Saturday, May 22 in the Beal Grand Corridor Gallery at Cedarhurst Center for the Arts. Featured in the exhibit, cosponsored by Krehbiel & Associates are 2-D and 3-D works from a variety of regional and national artists including Harry Bertoia, Mary Sprague, Cheonae Kim and Herbert Fink. Kim, a graduate of Southern Illinois University - Carbondale, has many national exhibition and permanent installation credits. Fink (1921-2006) served as professor of Art and chairman of the SIU-C Art Department (1961-1971). The early abstract work is rarely associated with Fink who is best known for his landscapes and nudes.

The Beck Family Center Gallery will open the exhibit Totally Tubular: featuring SAC after school artists. The exhibition cosponsored by Beck Bus Transportation Corp., features ceramic art and impressionist paintings by the Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday kindergarten through 8th grade Shrode Art Center after-school classes. Each month the after school program is focused on a different art media. The March 2010 classes learned about drawing and painting and impressionist Claude Monet. In April the students studied clay and relief textures in clay as well as sea animals and local fish species.

The Cedarhurst Clay Club and Cedarhurst's Fibers et Al. groups will be showcased in the Slip and Stitch exhibit in the Regenhardt Gallery at Shrode Art Center. The local artists meet on a regular schedule at Cedarhurst to learn, share and create art. The exhibition, cosponsored by Byrd-Watson Drug Company will feature a variety of ceramic art including Raku work and fiber art ranging from weaving to fiber dyeing techniques.
