City Water Information

Water Deposits

All new customers and most rental customers are required to pay a deposit prior to moving in. Deposits can be made at City Hall, 1100 Main Street.

Residential Deposit:\$100.00Commercial Deposit:\$150.00 minimum

Connection of Services

The following information will be needed for new accounts: name, service address, billing address, telephone number, and social security number. If you rent or lease, you will also need your lease agreement.

Billing Information

Payment is due in the office 16 days after the bill date. Water service will be disconnected if the balance remains unpaid. To have service restored, the account balance must be paid in full plus a minimum administrative fee of \$25.00. For reconnection of services after normal business hours, an additional overtime charge of \$150.00 will be assessed. Failure to receive a bill or notice, or being out of town, does not relieve the customer of their responsibility to pay the bill. Please notify our office if you experience problems receiving your bill.

Bills may be paid by mail, in person at City Hall, at drop boxes located in City Hall parking lot and in front of the Appellate Courthouse or pay online at mtvernon.com.

Every customer, residential and commercial, has a water meter. All meters are read monthly. All active accounts will be sent a minimum bill. An account is considered active if utilities are on at the meter. The billing rate per 1,000 gallons consumed is added to the minimum to calculate the total bill.



Illegal Tampering

The City of Mt. Vernon strictly prohibits tampering with sewer manhole lids or turning on/off any fire hydrants, water valves, or water meters, including removal of lockout devices that have been installed by City personnel. Violators are subject to and will be prosecuted under applicable laws. \$50.00 fine.

Disconnection & Reconnection

If you are moving and wish to discontinue service, notify the Billing Services office at City Hall at least 24 hours in advance. Please have your forwarding address available.

The City has the right to disconnect service for the following reasons:

- 1. Non-payment of bills
- 2. Returned bills that were unable to forward
- 3. Returned checks
- 4. Falsifying billing information
- 5. Illegal use of water
- 6. Refusal to allow the Water Department to inspect your meter, yard, or building
- 7. Non-compliance with City rules and regulations

Emergency Water Service

The City of Mt. Vernon has personnel available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week to correct or assist with any problems with your water service. If an emergency occurs after hours, please call the Mt. Vernon Police Department at 618-242-2131. Please limit after-hour calls to emergencies only. Billing or other questions will be answered during normal business hours at 618-242-6819.

Trash Service/Yard Waste/Bulk Pick-up/Recycling

The City of Mt. Vernon contracts these services with Republic Services.

Trash Pick Up: All trash needs to be curbside beginning at 6:00 a.m. on pick up day. If the company misses your tote on pickup day, contact Republic Services 1-800-634-0215 (printed on tote). The city requires totes to be removed from curb within 24 hours after pick up.

Holiday schedule: The following days will be observed. New Year's Day, Martin Luther King Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day. Trash pickup service will run one day late following each of these holidays.

Trash Totes: Each resident will be supplied with one 96-gallon tote. Totes are to be placed at curbside or in alleyways with the arrow pointing forward. Any customer wanting an additional tote will need to contact Republic Services. Please call 800-634-0215 for additional tote information.

Report missing or damaged totes to Republic Services: 800-634-0215.

Residential Yard Waste Collection: Yard waste will be collected year-round. Customers with regular trash service on Monday and Tuesday will have their yard waste picked up on Tuesday. Customers with regular trash service on Wednesday and Friday will have their yard waste picked up on Wednesday. Customers with trash service on Thursday will have their yard waste picked up on Thursday. **Bulk waste pickup:** Bulk items, i.e. furniture, mattresses, small appliances or other materials from a residential source will be picked up at the request of the customer. **No electronics accepted**. Please call Republic Services customer service at 800-634-0215. You must call customer service by Wednesday to have items picked up on Friday.

Construction materials: i.e. roofing materials, drywall, siding, room additions or remodeling material. **No paint accepted**. Republic Services will offer roll-off containers for these types of materials in 10, 20, and 30 cubic yard containers to the residents of Mt. Vernon. Please call customer service at 1-800-634-0215 for more information.

Recycle Totes: One tote will be supplied to each resident for recycled materials. Each resident will be supplied with a separate recycling tote. Recycling totes are to be placed at curbside or in alleyways with the arrow pointing forward.
